Make reading fun and COOK TOGETHER!

During these cold, snowy days include some non-fiction reading and a tasty treat into your day.

1. Find a recipe that you and a family member can make at home sometime this week or use the recipe that follows.
2. Read the recipe together; then have your helper read it again.
3. Create a list of ingredients needed for the recipe. Write the ingredients on the grocery list. Make sure you have

included the amounts of ingredients on the list.

4. Shop for the food with a family member. Make sure all the food on the recipe is ready before you cook.
5. Read and reread the recipe as you put ingredients together.
6. While the food is cooking or after you have finished, make a list of five interesting or new words you found in the recipe (For example: blend)
7. Write about your cooking experiences in a journal and/or draw a picture of yourself cooking at home.

Plastic Bag Fudge

This is an easy recipe that can be made anywhere from in the car on a road trip to camping or even at home in front of a good movie. Note: this recipe may be divided into smaller portions and made in sandwich bags so that every kid has their own bag.

SERVES 6 - 10

Ingredients

- * 3 ounces cream cheese
- * 1 lb powdered sugar
- * 6 tablespoons hot cocoa mix or 1/2 cup cocoa
- * 2 tablespoons butter
- * 1 gallon ziploc bag

Directions

1. Place all ingredients in the Ziploc bag. Close bag well. (You may choose to place inside an additional bag to reduce the risk of spills).
2. Squish all ingredients in the bag by hand to mix. Mix until smooth (at least 10 to 15 min) -- Enjoy!
