Dress Code Reminder

With the weather getting warmer, we wanted to remind parents of a few points regarding the district dress code.

- 1. Lower body articles of clothing must be hemmed and must cover the body from the waist to the middle thigh; students will not wear short shorts, biker pants, athletic shorts, or mini skirts.**
- 2. Upper body articles of clothing should cover the body from shoulders to waist; shirts exposing the midriff at any time will not be acceptable.**
- 3. Shirts must have some type of sleeve, and the armholes should contain a hem and not expose more than the arm or underarm area.**
- 4. Students must wear shoes to school that are safe and appropriate for the school environment.**

As our students usually go out for recess on nice days and they run and skip in gym and music class, we recommend that our students wear tennis shoes or shoes that fully protect the foot.
