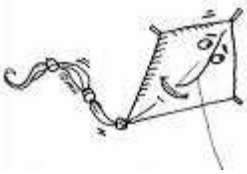

Owl Pellet Investigation Coming Up!



All 5th grade classes will be dissecting the pellets of Barn Owls as a science investigation within the next few weeks. Students will examine and classify the contents.

Owl pellets are the regurgitated undigested remains of the prey of barn owls. They are a natural educational tool. Our objective is for the students to better understand the role of owls in our local ecosystem, to determine the diet of the barn owl through exploration, to experience the nature of food chains, to learn basic skeletal anatomy, and most importantly to develop increased interest in the natural world around them.

Our pellets have been ordered from a reputable science instructional company, and the pellets have been sterilized by heat, using no chemicals.

This should be a fun and educational experience for our students (and their teachers)!
